Founded in 1936 as a rural farm and residential contractor, Dunbar Mechanical has grown to one of the 100 largest mechanical contractors in the nation. The Dunbar Mechanical Service Group works throughout N.W. Ohio and Southern Michigan, providing preventive maintenance and replacement of HVAC systems through a fleet of more than 30 service vehicles.
