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### **11 NEW CONTRACTORS JOIN ELITE MSCA STAR PROGRAM**

#### **69 MSCA members now STAR qualified nationwide**

ROCKVILLE, MD— The Mechanical Service Contractors of America (MSCA) is pleased to announce that 11 new contractors have qualified for MSCA STAR status. MSCA STAR is a national qualification program which honors companies who meet or exceed stringent operating and training standards set by MSCA.

To become a STAR contractor, companies must complete a detailed application which covers a wide range of criteria, including employing the best trained and most qualified workforce, maintaining a superior safety record, offering outstanding customer service, and focusing on continuing education and training for all employees.

The 11 new STAR contractors join 18 additional MSCA members to have qualified for STAR this year. Twenty-eight of the 2006 STAR-qualified companies were recognized at the recent MSCA national conference in Charleston, SC on October 15-18. A total of 69 MSCA member companies have reached STAR status since the program was introduced in 2004.

STAR-qualified companies are confirmed and verified by MSCA, the nation's leading organization representing commercial and industrial heating, ventilating, air conditioning and refrigeration contractors and the NITC (National Inspection, Testing and Certification), an ISO 9001 and ANSI accredited certifying organization.
