To apply for MSCA STAR qualification, a contractor must complete a detailed application and submit copies of its safety program, safety record, inventory control system, education and training programs for employees, customer service program, and letters of recommendation. An independent evaluation of the applications is performed by the National ITC Corporation of Los Angeles, CA. Once companies have been qualified as MSCA STARS they receive a complete packet of marketing materials plus a certificate of recognition and other promotional materials.
